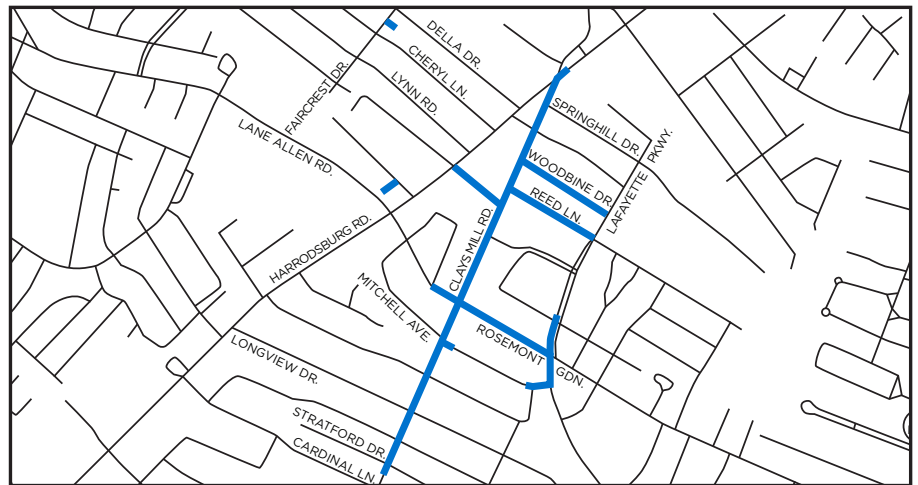

## PARDON OUR MESS

As part of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Clays Mill Road improvement project, Columbia Gas is required to relocate the natural gas distribution system in your neighborhood. Please be prepared for digging and disruptions as we complete this work.

While this work is mandated, the replacement of approximately 18,000 feet of state-of-the-art pipe will enhance the safety and reliability of natural gas service, will require less future maintenance and for some customers will support amenities like fire pits, outdoor grills and pool heaters. This project includes the replacement of the main line, which runs under the street, sidewalk or easement; service lines that run from the main line to the natural gas meter on your property; and meters at each home or business.

The project area is pictured below.



**Timing:** Construction started in January ahead of roadwork. To complete this project as efficiently as possible, our crews plan to work Monday through Saturday between 7:30 am and 5:30 pm. In some instances, evening and weekend work may occur to accommodate customer appointments or project deadlines and to alleviate traffic congestion.

**Service Impacts:** Customers in the immediate construction area may experience brief service interruptions as new house lines and meters are installed. We will communicate with you and schedule this work in advance.
