1.0 Public Engagement Overview

Columbia Gas ("Columbia") has developed a multi-pronged public engagement plan to inform the affected property owners and residents and adjacent properties (collectively, the "Project Stakeholders") of the Project. Columbia has taken several pre-application steps to communicate with the public about the replacing of an existing natural gas transmission line by installing approximately 5.3 miles of 20-inch diameter and 1.4 miles of 12 inch diameter steel natural gas pipeline in the Woodward Park area ("Project"). Initially, Columbia established a website to provide the public with information and Frequently Asked Questions ("FAQ") about the Project. Columbia also established a phone line (800-242-6227) and email address (NCHP@nisource.com) to address specific customer questions and concerns about the Project. Columbia intends to maintain this website to communicate with customers during the siting and construction of the Project. As required by the Ohio Power Siting Board regulations, Columbia also hosted three Public Informational Meetings ("PIMs") with details below.

Below are details of the above-described events, in addition to the other methods Columbia used to engage the public and collect feedback.

1.1 Project Website

The Project website can be found at ColumbiaGasOhio.com/Woodward-Park-NCHP. The Project website provides an overview of the Project, including sections on project needs, benefits, the routing process, and the overall timeline. The site also features an interactive route map that allows the public to leave comments. Furthermore, the webpage lists multiple contact methods (phone number and email) for the public and includes a FAQ section to address common questions.

The majority of visitors to the Project website utilized the website link, with 60% of traffic coming from direct sources, meaning users either typed the URL directly or accessed the site through a shared link. Referral traffic, which accounted for 14% of visitors coming from other websites, was the most engaged audience, spending an average of more than three minutes on the site.

1.1.1 Interactive Map

The Interactive Map on the website allows landowners to see how the Project may affect their property and provides an opportunity to submit comments specific to their property. In addition to being on the website, attendees at the in-person PIMs were able to sit with Subject Matter Specialists to find their property and log comments. Consistent themes of the comments were related to traffic and access concerns, construction impacts, protection of trees and community features, and drainage and utility questions. In total, there were 35 comments documented on the map.

1.2 Questionnaires

Another way the Project team gathered public feedback was through a formal questionnaire. Paper copies of the questionnaire were available at each PIM. In total, 38 responses were received by May 14, 2026. Key themes of the feedback included concerns regarding routing through residential neighborhoods, potential construction impacts, safety considerations, and requests for additional opportunities for public discussion. The figures below highlight these themes and more.

2.0 In-Person Public Informational Meetings

2.1 Process

In accordance with Ohio Power Siting Board requirements, the in-person PIMs were conducted to provide the public with opportunities to learn about the Project, ask questions, and submit comments to the Project team either verbally or through a provided questionnaire.

The PIMs were organized into stations covering different aspects of the Project, including welcome, Project planning steps, purpose & need, Project timeline, environmental & vegetation management, traffic management, construction, health & safety, state & federal requirements, and an area to provide public feedback via questionnaires and Interactive Map stations. Each station was staffed with Subject Matter Specialists to whom guests could ask specific questions. The set-up allowed guests to ask questions and visit stations at their own pace.

Attendees were able to look at proposed Project routes through physical maps on boards or at the Interactive Map stations where there were Interactive Map specialists to help them find their property and leave comments in the system.

See the table in section 2.3 for the dates and locations of the PIMs.

2.2 Notification

A mailing list for Franklin County was developed for the October meeting using parcel data obtained from the Franklin County Assessor based on the Project route. For the October 2025 PIM, the county data was pulled on August 22, 2025. A new mailing list for Franklin County was developed for the April and May PIMs based on the route updates. For the April and May 2026 PIM, the county data was pulled on March 9, 2026. Notifications for the PIMs were mailed to properties located within 500 feet of the proposed alignment.

Prior to the PIM in October 2025, notifications were sent to property owners and tenants totaling 3,676 notifications. For the April and May 2026 meetings notifications were sent to property owners and tenants totaling 6,736 notifications.

2.3 Franklin County In-Person Public Informational Meeting Summary

Due to routing adjustments and the statutory timeline, there were three in-person PIMs for Franklin County held on the following days - October 5th, 2025, from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM, April 8th, 2026, from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM, and on May 7th, 2026, from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Appendix A– October 1, 2025, Public Informational Meeting

Approximately 35 individuals attended the PIM on October 1, 2025. Attendees had the opportunity to directly address subject matter specialists from Columbia and their representatives, submit questions via written or mailed questionnaires, and provide input through interactive map stations available at the PIM. Eleven written comments were received during the PIM on October 1, 2025. Attendees had the opportunity to mail in questionnaires until October 15, 2025, and none were received. Most of the written questionnaires received at this PIM involved concerns associated with specific details related to construction, the overall Project timeline, and Project Route. Ten interactive map comments were received during the PIM on October 1, 2025. Most interactive map comments received at this PIM involved concerns associated with ways to mitigate potential landscape and construction impacts or questions about the construction timeline.

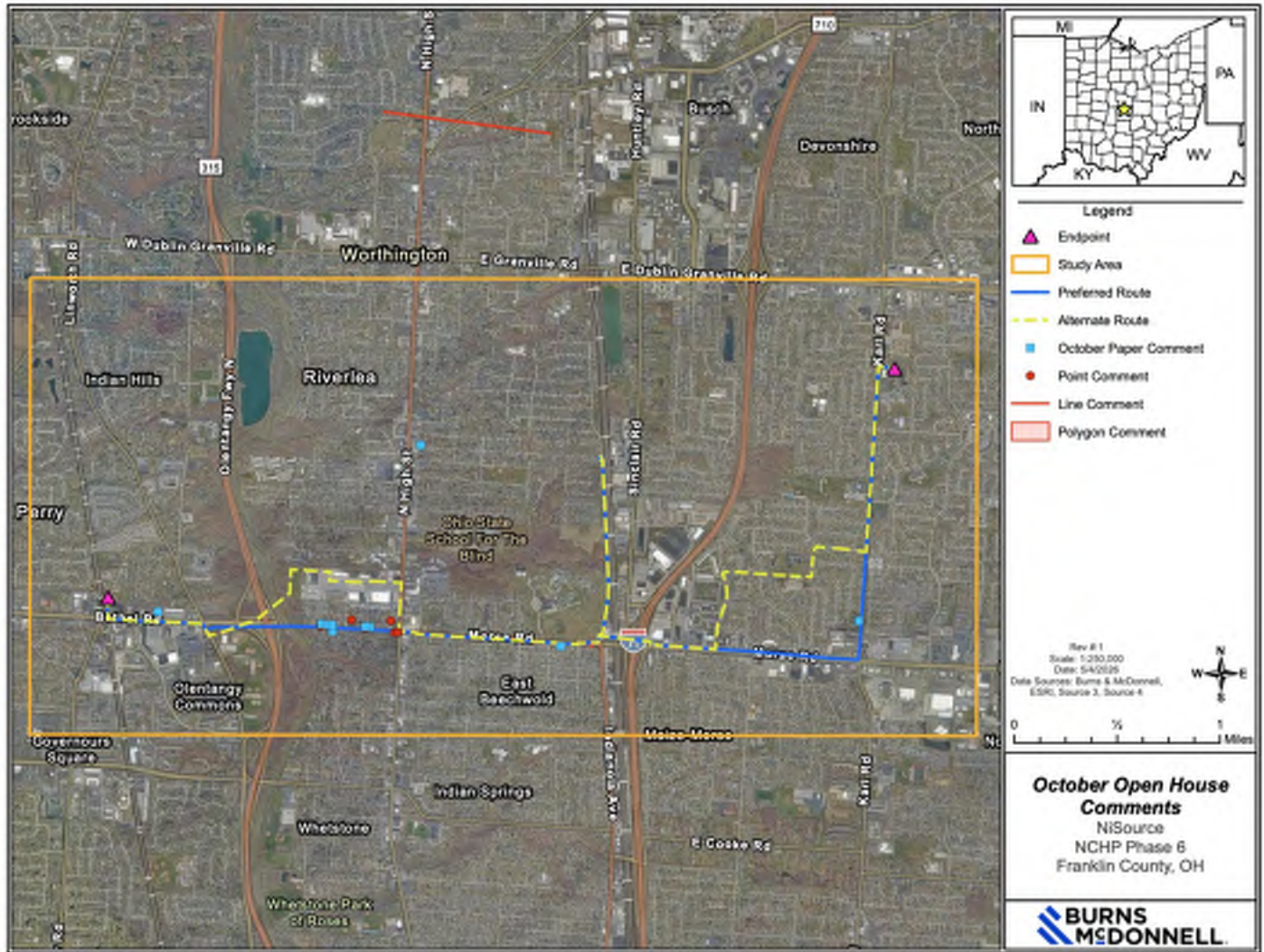

State & Federal Requirements

Federal level

As stated in the Project Planning board, one of the needs for this Project is Columbia Gas's commitment to continued compliance with federal pipeline requirements and the modernization and strengthening of Columbia Gas's natural gas infrastructure for long-term safety and reliability.

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA") has begun implementing a comprehensive, three-part rule, aimed at increasing pipeline safety throughout the

natural gas industry across the country. These regulations are commonly known as the PHMSA Mega Rule.

Compliance with the Mega Rule must be completed within specific timeframes and targets specific parts of natural gas delivery systems.

Mega Rule compliance involves enhanced repair requirements and assessments of the existing system.

State level

After collecting public feedback, Columbia will file an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB"), the OPSB is a state agency that considers requests for approval of large electric and natural gas infrastructure projects.

Columbia Gas will proceed only after receiving all necessary approvals and route certifications.

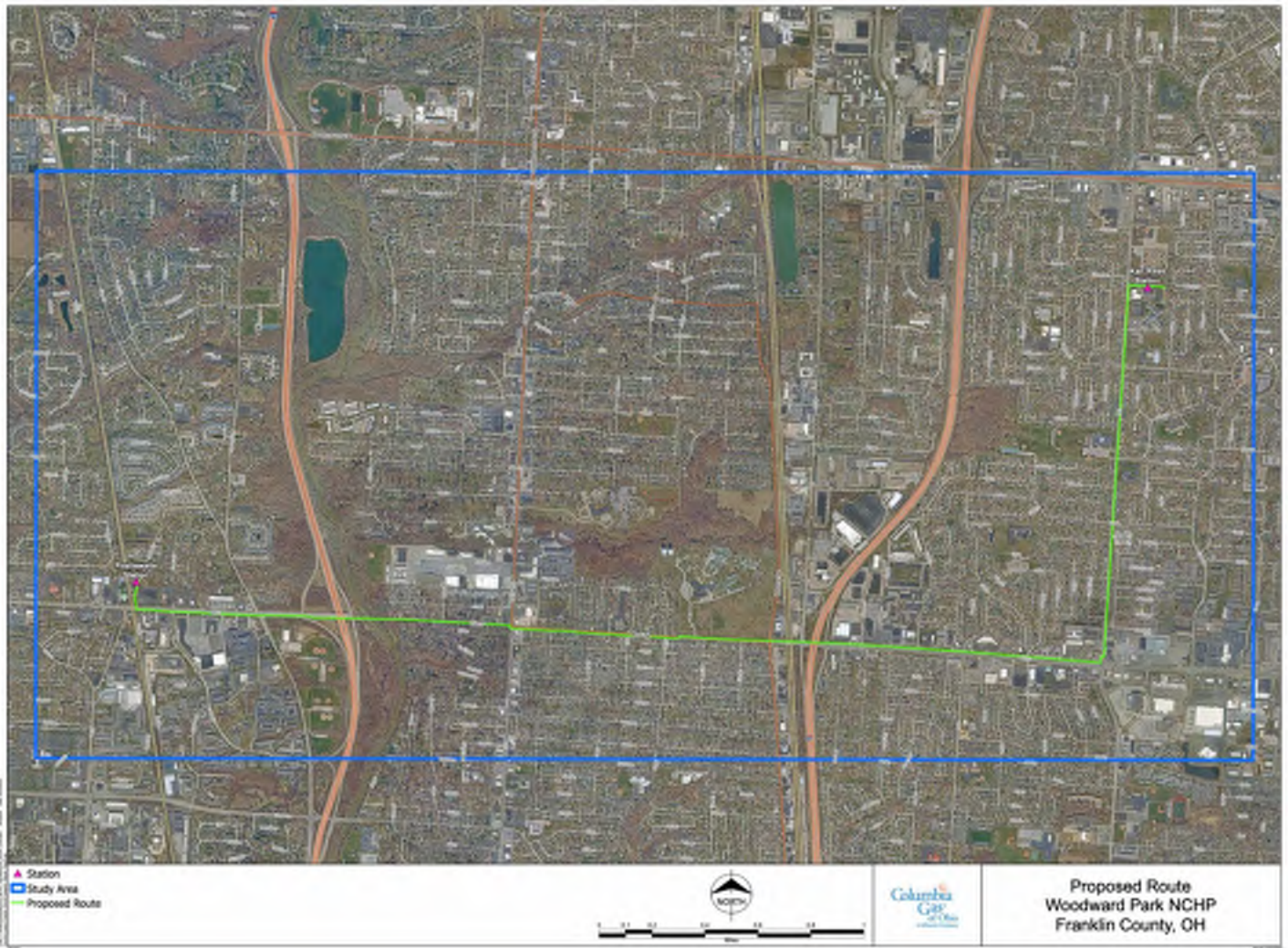

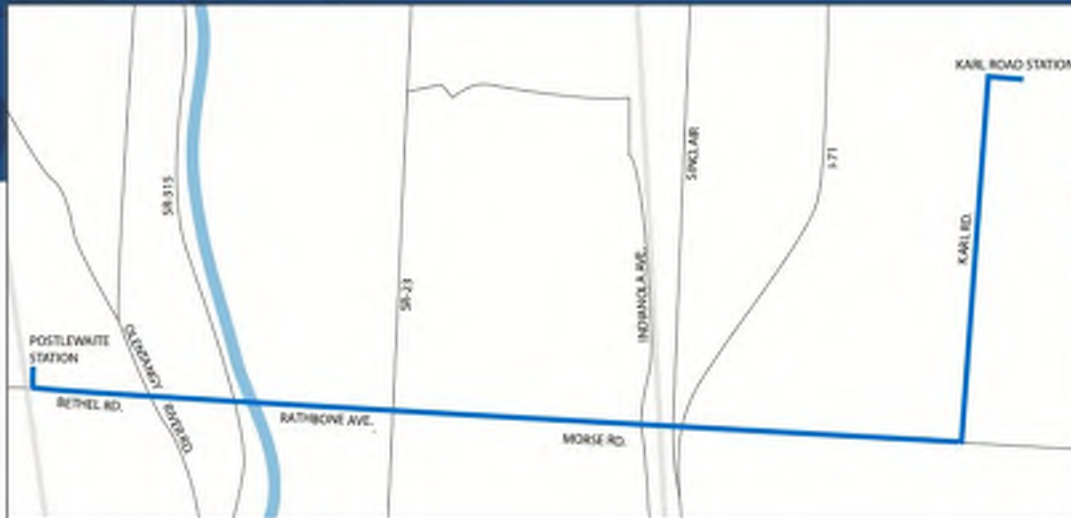

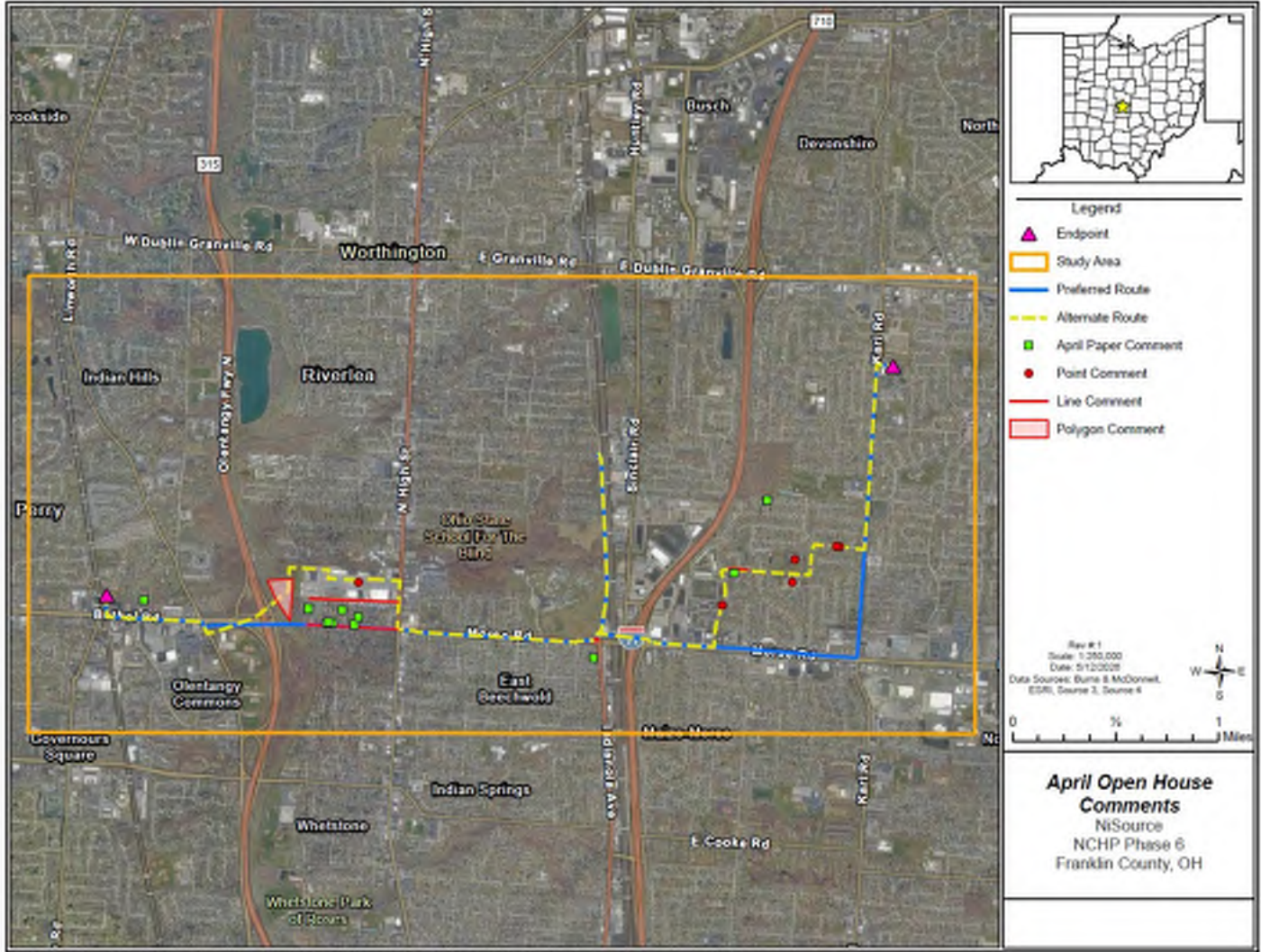

Federal level

As stated in the Project Planning board, one of the needs for this Project is Columbia Gas's commitment to continued compliance with federal pipeline requirements and the modernization and strengthening of Columbia Gas's natural gas infrastructure for long-term safety and reliability.

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA") has begun implementing a comprehensive, three-part rule, aimed at increasing pipeline safety throughout the

natural gas industry across the country. These regulations are commonly known as the PHMSA Mega Rule.

Compliance with the Mega Rule must be completed within specific timeframes and targets specific parts of natural gas delivery systems.

Mega Rule compliance involves enhanced repair requirements and assessments of the existing system.

State level

After collecting public feedback, Columbia will file an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB"). The OPSB is a state agency that considers requests for approval of large electric and natural gas infrastructure projects.

Columbia Gas will proceed only after receiving all necessary approvals and route certifications.

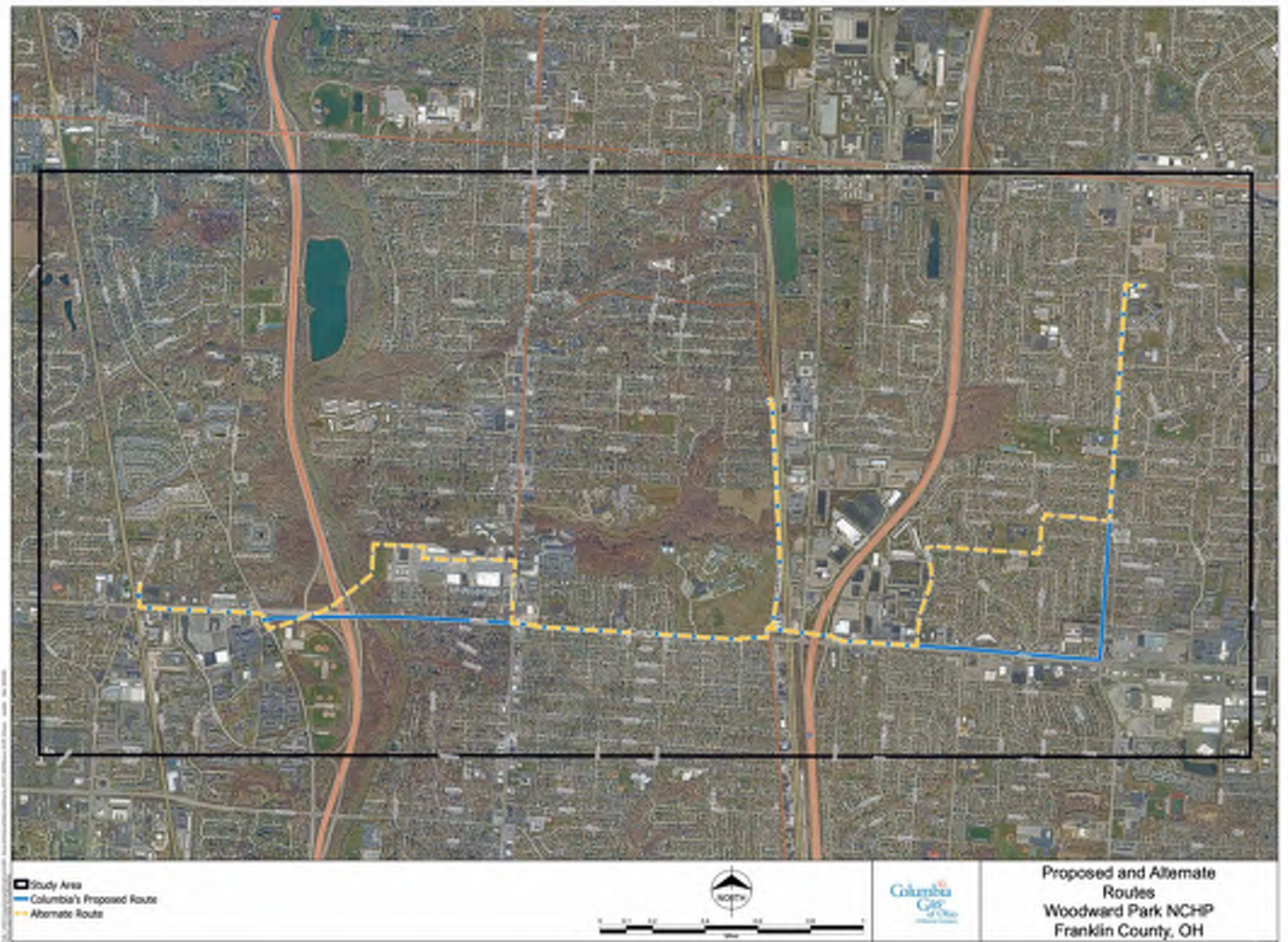

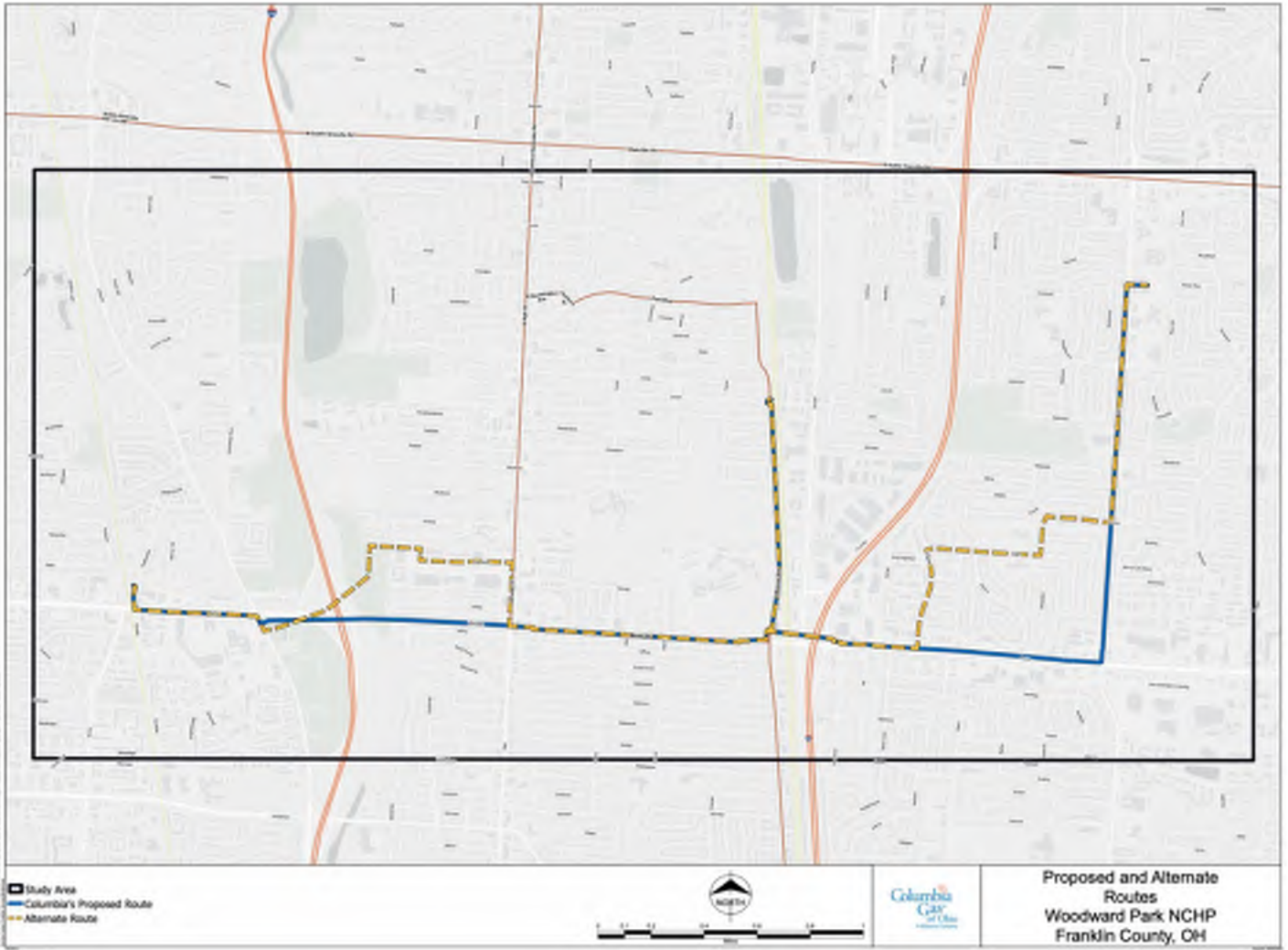

Appendix C- May 7, 2026, Public Informational Meeting

Approximately 28 individuals attended the PIM on May 7, 2026. Attendees had the opportunity to directly address subject matter specialists from Columbia and their representatives, submit questions via written or mailed questionnaires, and provide input through interactive map stations available at the PIM.

At the PIM on May 7, 2026, an additional 'How We Serve You' board was added that illustrated the flow of natural gas from the compressor station, through the interstate pipeline, to the city gate metering station where custody of the gas is transferred to the utility, then to the area gas regulator station, and ultimately through the distribution system.

Twelve written comments were received during the PIM on May 7, 2026. Most of the written comments received at this PIM involved concerns associated with the route and potential impacts to infrastructure and residences, anticipated construction timeline and process, and potential impacts to landscaping and surrounding community features. Attendees had the opportunity to mail questionnaires until May 21, 2026, and none were received. Fourteen interactive map comments were received during the PIM on May 7, 2026. Most of the interactive map comments received at this PIM involved concerns associated with disruptions to traffic or community activities and mitigating impact to surrounding landscaping.

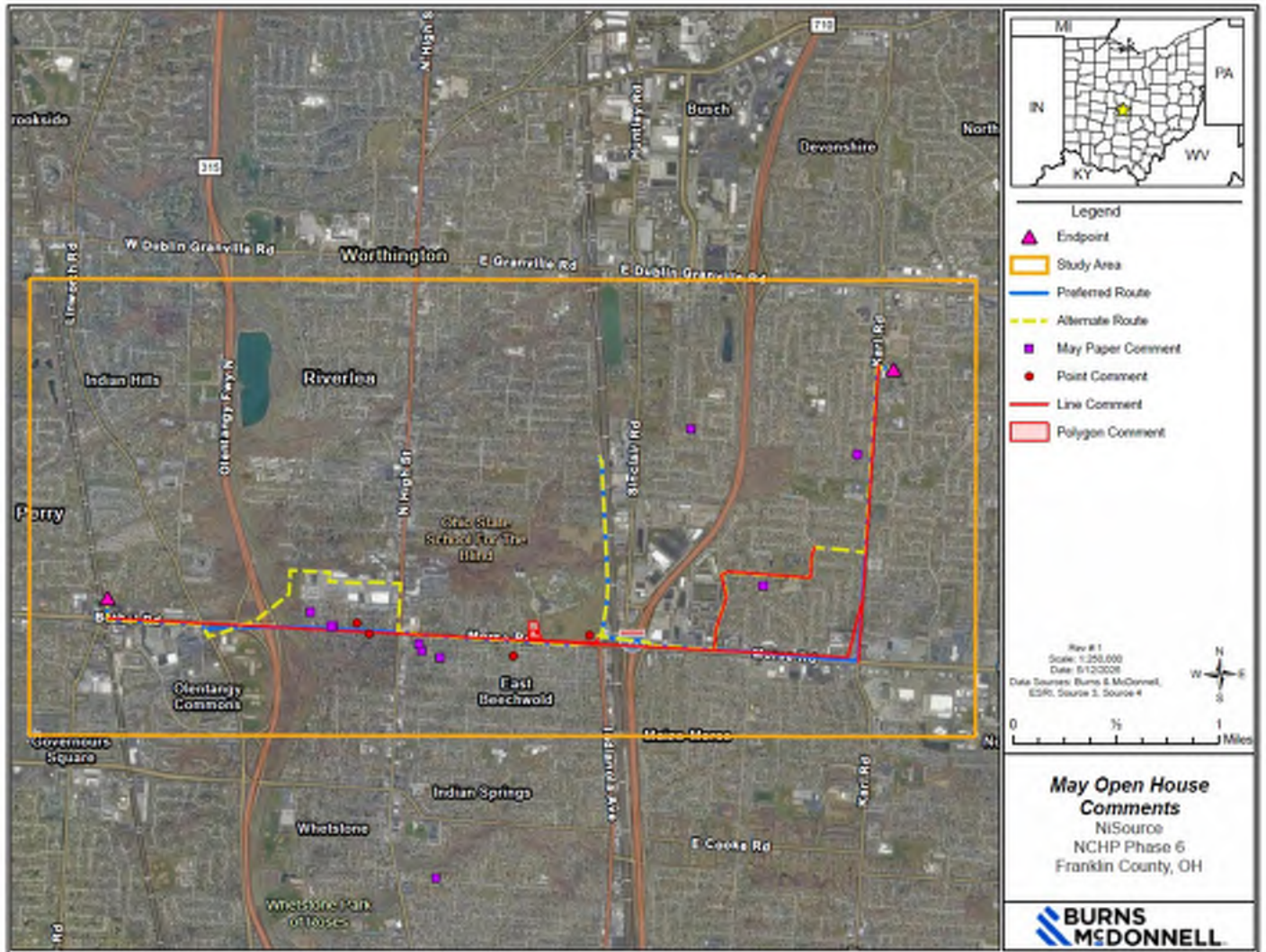

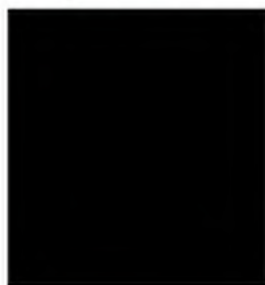

The OPSB reviews the application and, if certain criteria are met, approves the project. If the project is approved, the OPSB issues a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. If approved, construction is anticipated to start in early 2027 and complete in December 2027.

State & Federal Requirements

Federal level

As stated in the Project Planning board, one of the needs for this Project is Columbia Gas's commitment to continued compliance with federal pipeline requirements and the modernization and strengthening of Columbia Gas's natural gas infrastructure for long-term safety and reliability.

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) has begun implementing a comprehensive, three-part rule, aimed at increasing pipeline safety throughout the

natural gas industry across the country. These regulations are commonly known as the PHMSA Mega Rule.

Compliance with the Mega Rule must be completed within specific timeframes and targets specific parts of natural gas delivery systems.

Mega Rule compliance involves enhanced repair requirements and assessments of the existing system.

State level

After collecting public feedback, Columbia will file an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB). The OPSB is a state agency that considers requests for approval of large electric and natural gas infrastructure projects.

Columbia Gas will proceed only after receiving all necessary approvals and route certifications.

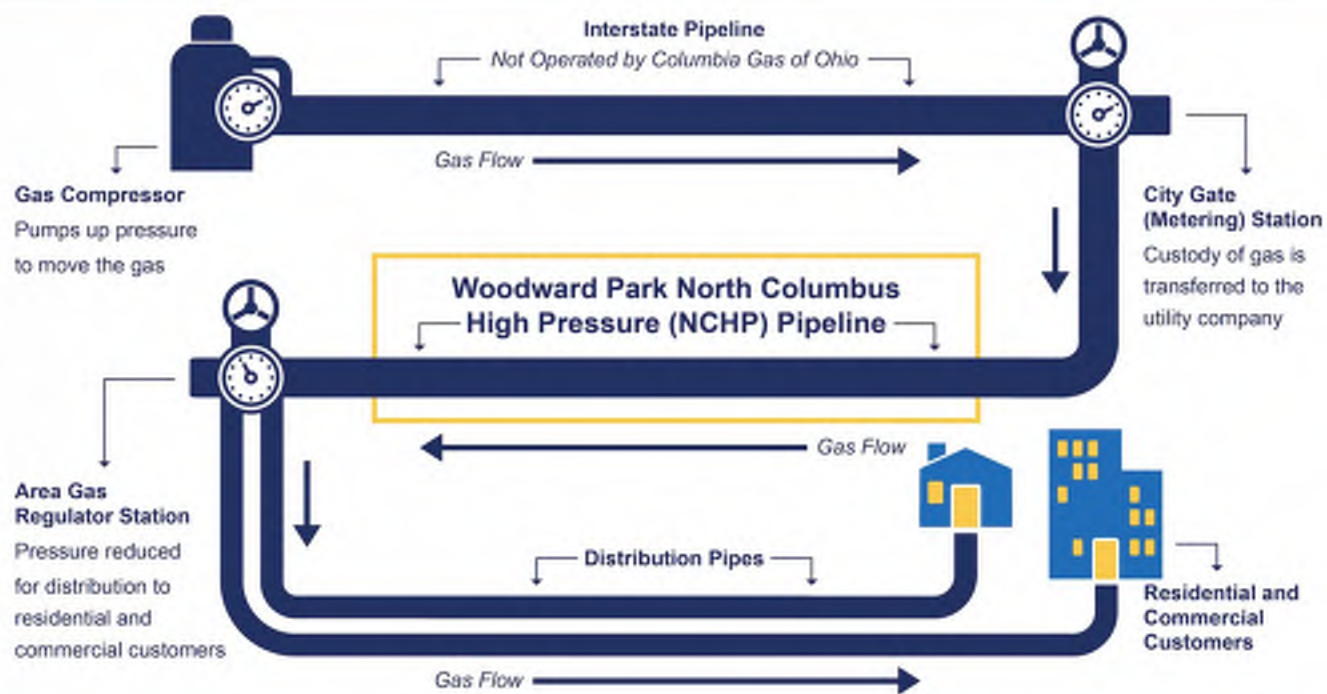

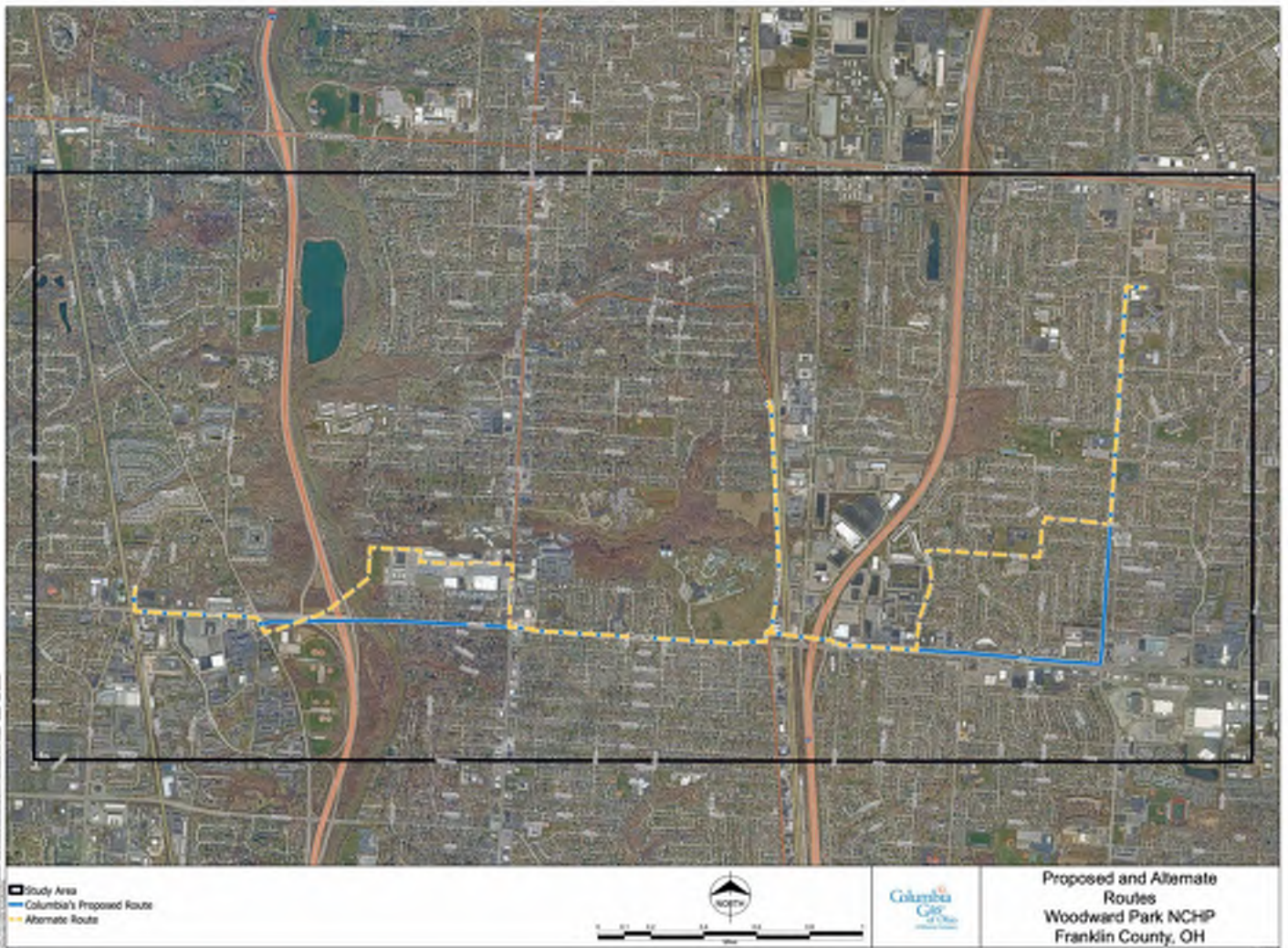


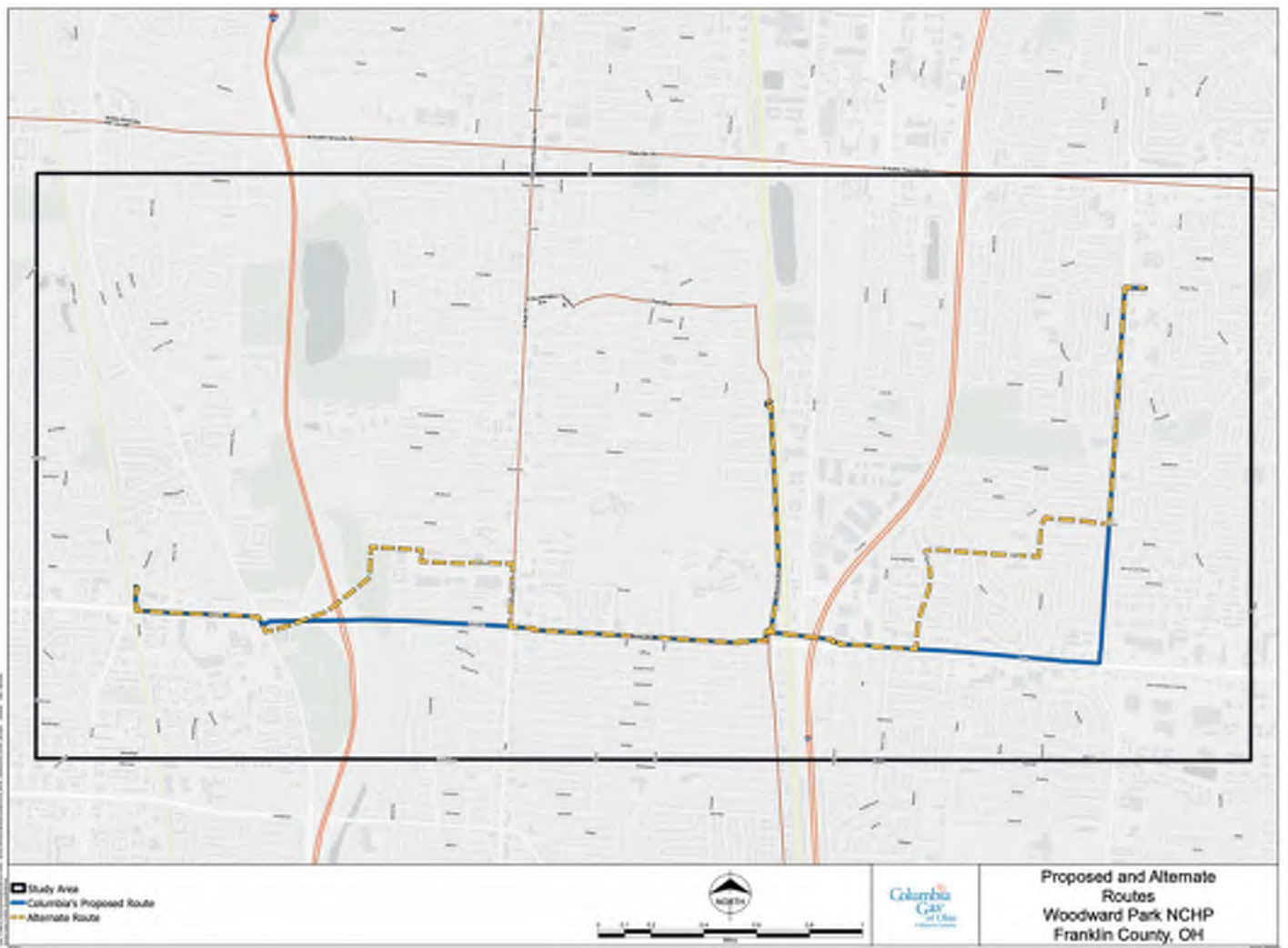
