Woodward Park NCHP Public Informational Meeting

Columbia Gas is currently preparing for the Woodward Park North Columbus High Pressure (NCHP) Pipeline Project in your community. The project involves replacing existing gas lines in the Woodward Park area by installing approximately 5.3 miles of new 20-inch diameter and 1.3 miles of new 12-inch steel natural gas pipeline to support the central Ohio system.

This project is designed to:

- **Modernize** and strengthen Columbia Gas's natural gas infrastructure for long-term safety and reliability
- **Improve** energy delivery to better serve homes, businesses and future growth
- **Replace** aging infrastructure with advanced, efficient systems
- **Increase** system flexibility to adapt to evolving customer needs and energy demands
- **Continue** to comply with federal pipeline requirements

As part of the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) process, we invite you to attend our Woodward Park NCHP Public Informational Meeting to learn more about the project. This will be a drop-in-style event where subject matter specialists will be available to answer your questions regarding the scope of the work, the proposed route and the project schedule. During the Public Informational Meeting, Columbia Gas will collect feedback from the community regarding the project and the proposed route. This second meeting is an opportunity to share information that will be included in the OPSB application.

Columbia Gas must submit an application to, and obtain approval from, the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) to construct the project. The application submitted to the OPSB is required to include information on a proposed route for the project, the Woodward Park North Columbus High Pressure (NCHP) Pipeline Project, among other things.

The OPSB reviews the application and, if certain criteria are met, approves the project. If the project is approved, the OPSB issues a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. If approved, construction is anticipated to start in early 2027 and complete in December 2027.

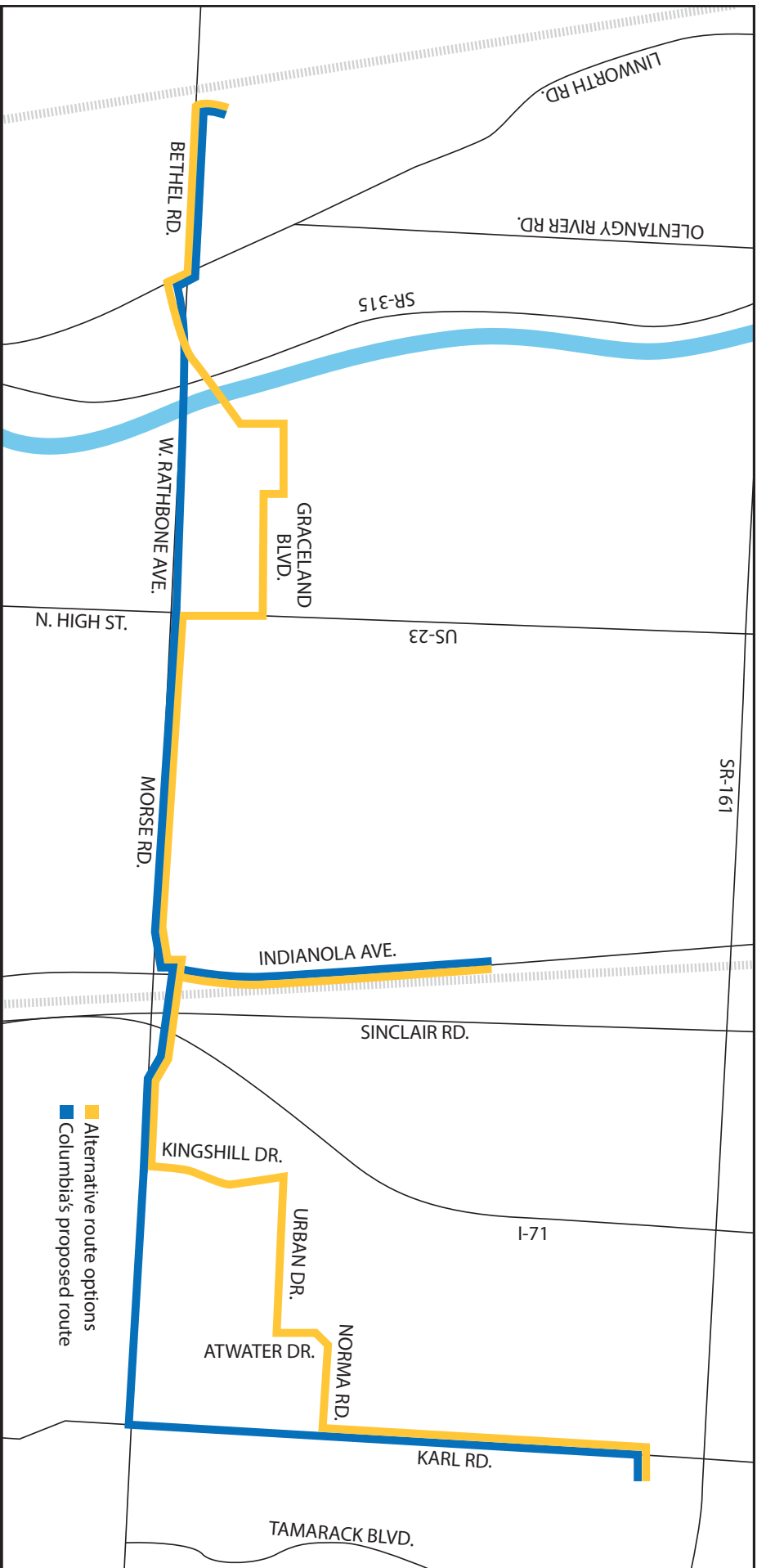
