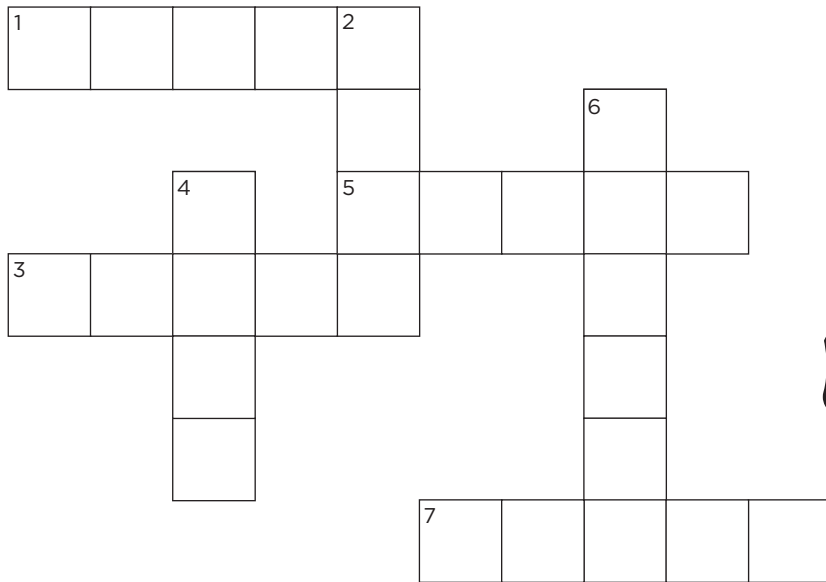




Digger Dog[®] can smell anything
